In celebration of World Environment Day and in support of the beat plastic pollution movement, GEDA is proud to take another step towards sustainability by introducing personalised stainless steel travel mugs for all employees - a small but impactful action in reducing our environmental footprint.

These mugs, each individually initialled, are made from 90% recycled, post-consumer 304-grade stainless steel, and they mark a significant move in our efforts to cut down on waste. With 160 team members making the switch, we'll collectively save an estimated 11,360 disposable coffee cups each year.
